

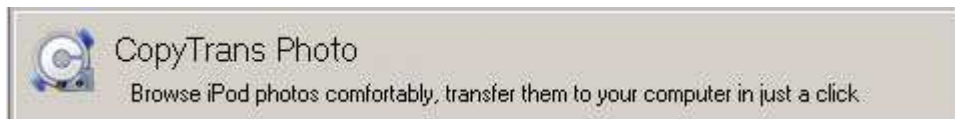
CopyTrans Photo – User Guide

Transfer photos from PC to iPod or iPhone & vice-versa

In this tutorial we will show you how easy it is to drag pictures out of your PC to copy them into your iPod. Quickly learn how to add photos from any iPod photo, iPhone or iTouch to your computer and much more! Manage, copy & enjoy watching your best iPod & PC photos! Create, organize & rename iPod photo albums now!

Open CopyTrans Photo

Before you connect your iPod, iPhone or iPod Touch to the computer, close iTunes (if opened) and open CopyTrans Photo. To do so, go to the CopyTrans Control Center, in the Start menu (Start menu -> Programs -> CopyTrans Suite -> CopyTrans Control Center) and click on CopyTrans Photo.

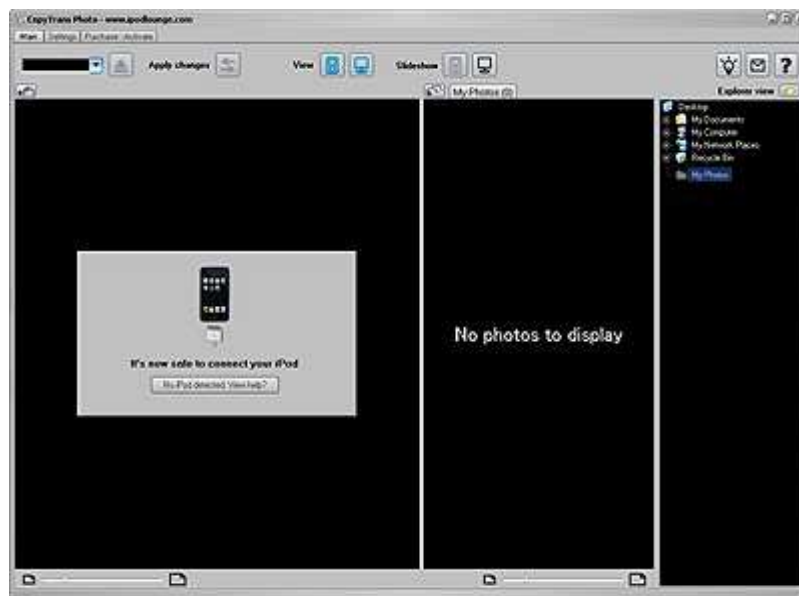


Program overview

As you can see on the following image, CopyTrans Photo has 2 main areas:

- The left-hand side window for the iPod pictures
- And the right-hand side window for the computer pictures

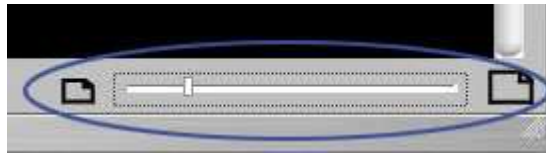
On the far right, there is an explorer that allows you to browse your computer folders.



If you need more working space and want a single window view, click on the blue iPod & Computer icons (See image below). To hide or to show the explorer, click the "Explorer view".



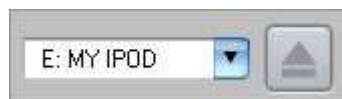
To adjust photo size, use the thumbnail resizing bar or press Ctrl + scroll wheel or Ctrl + Page Up / Page Down.



Connect your iPod ou iPhone

As soon as you open CopyTrans Photo, your iPod will be protected against iTunes' automatic detection & unwanted synchronizations.

Once the "It's now safe to connect your iPod" message appears, connect your iPod. In case your iPod is not detected, select it from the "Select iPod" list box in the top left corner or visit our help section <http://www.copytrans.net/helpphoto.php#22>



As soon as your iPod is detected, CopyTrans Photo will display your photos.



Copy photos from PC to iPod & iPhone!

Easily manage computer & iPod photos with CopyTrans Photo. Create, organize & rename iPod photo albums in just a click. Here, we'll show you how!

Create albums on your iPod & iPhone

Before copying photos to your iPod, you need to learn how to create new albums on your Apple player: Click on the "New Album" button (here, circled in blue), name the iPod album and click "OK".

iPhone users, your albums will be created in the iPhone's Photo Library, not in the Camera Roll. Remember that the Camera Roll only stores the pictures you have taken with the iPhone.



Create folders shortcuts

As shown on the following image, you can create folder shortcuts in Copytrans Photo to rapidly access your computer folders. The shortcut will be created based on the last open tab. Use the Explorer to open a new folder and double click on it. The pictures will be displayed and the shortcut will now be named according to the new folder.



To close a shortcut, right-click on it and select the "close" option on the popup menu.

Transfer PC Photos to iPod & iPhone

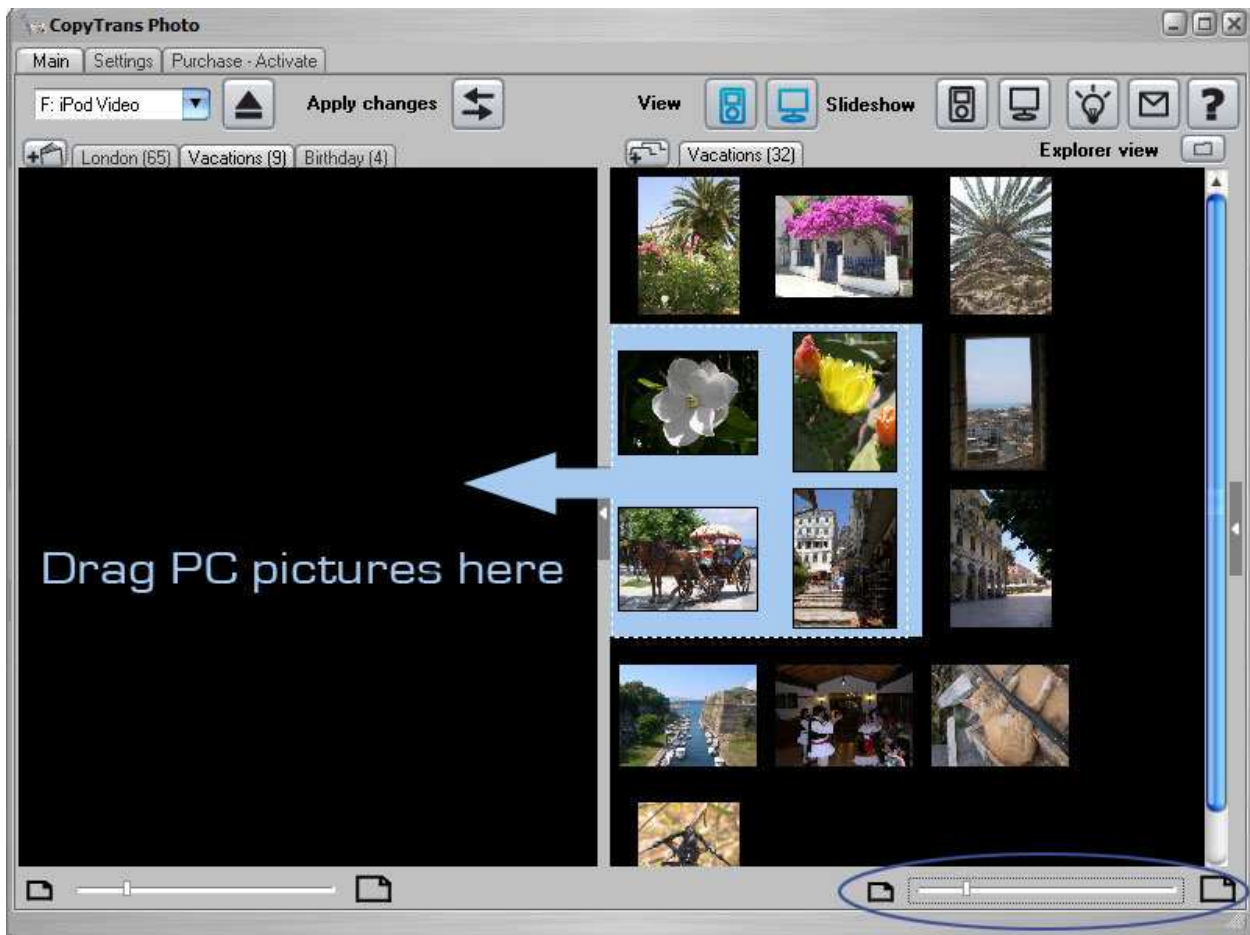
To transfer PC photos to your iPod, use the Explorer to select any folder on your computer and choose the pictures you want to add to the iPod. The selected photos will be highlighted in blue. Then, simply drag & drop the PC photos to the left-hand side window (see image below).

Note: the photos will only be copied once you click the "Apply changes" button. Learn more: http://www.copytrans.net/_gettingstartedphoto4.php

iPhone users, please note that you can transfer computer photos either to the iPhone's Photo Library or to an album, but not to the Camera Roll as it only contains the photos taken with the iPhone camera.

Hints:

- Click on a photo to select it
- To select all photos of an album or folder, press Ctrl + A or click with the right button of your mouse on any photo and choose "Select all"
- To quickly select several pictures but not all, keep the Shift key down while you click on photos to select several of them in a row or Ctrl to select several separated ones.



Transfer photos from iPod & iPhone to PC

To transfer iPod & iPhone photos to your PC, repeat the steps mentioned above, but this time in the other direction (from left to right).

Note: remember that the photos will only be added to your computer once you click the "Apply changes" button.



Apply changes

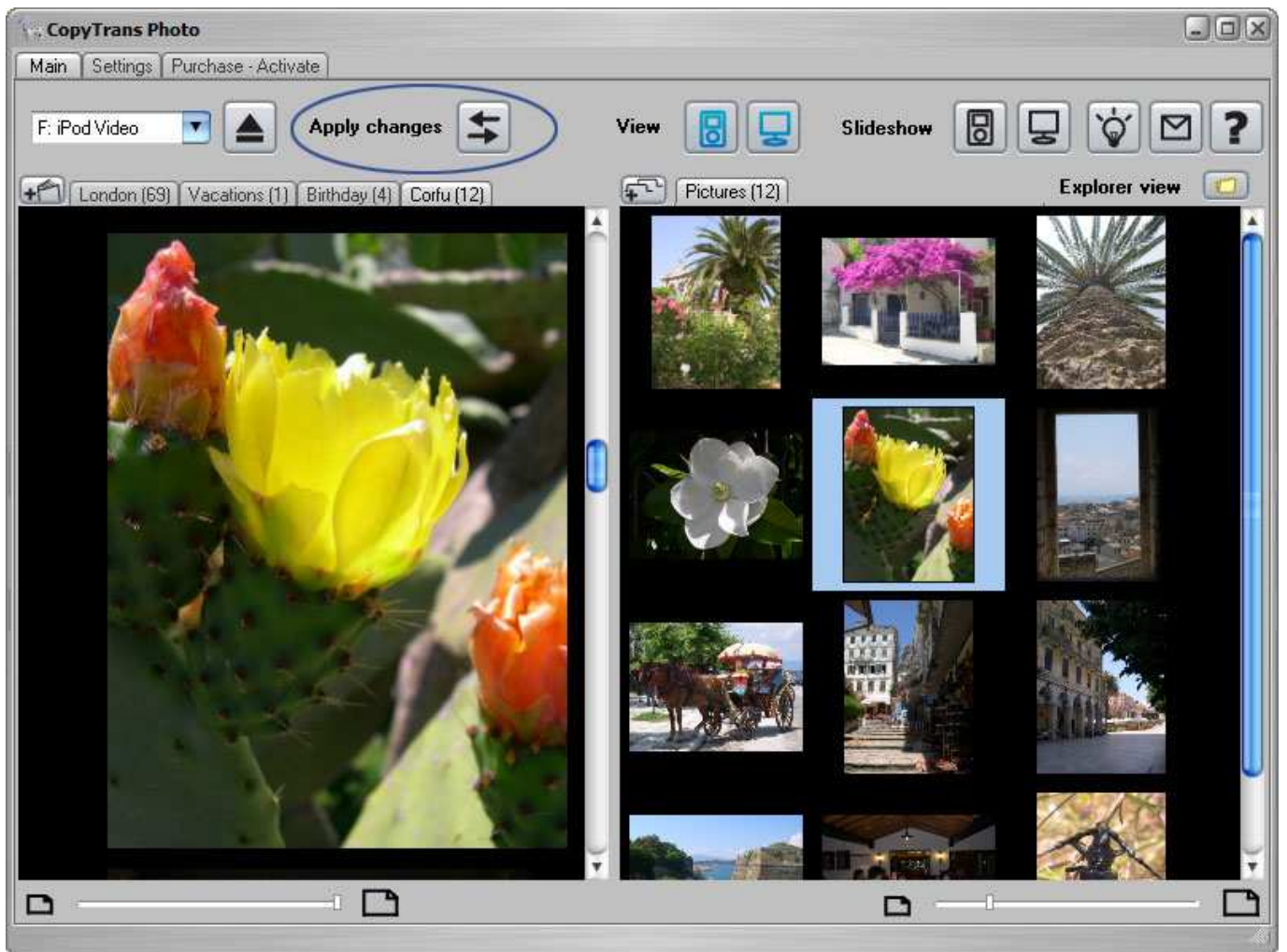
With CopyTrans Photo only the changes selected will be applied to your iPod & PC. You take the control of your iPod pictures, not iTunes. See how you can do it!

Finally, apply the changes you have made both to your computer & iPod pictures by clicking on the "Apply changes" button. In case you don't want the changes to take effect, just walk out of the application by closing it down.

To see the results on your iPhone or iPod Touch, please go back to the main menu and click on the Photos icon to refresh. You will see all your recently added photos appear on the screen.

Note: A slight watermark logo will be added to your photos when using the trial version of CopyTrans Photo. However, you can prevent CopyTrans Photo from adding watermarks to transferred photos by purchasing a license.
